mi ni ki no *your healthy dose of short films*

mi ni ki no is not a Japanese word.

mi ni ki no is a group of people who believes that a short film is a form of art that, like a poem or a short story, is a self-contained work of literature. Seizing this idea, mi ni ki no brings a unique selection of short films from around the world to audience in Indonesia and vice versa.

mi ni ki no runs a monthly screening and discussion to provide filmmakers with an opportunity to screen their work to a wider audience. mi ni ki no also provides film festivals both in and out of Indonesia with a unique selection of international or Indonesian short films. At the same time mi ni ki no provides its audience with an opportunity to see and discuss about films they might never get to see otherwise.

mi ni ki no is both regular & irregular.

mi ni ki no began its monthly screening and discussion in Denpasar (Bali, Indonesia) in September 2002. Since March 2003, mi ni ki no also screens in Jakarta (Indonesia), and since October 2003 in Bandung (Indonesia). These regular screening and discussions are non-profit and free-to-public.

mi ni ki no has also supplied and programmed for other film events and festivals both in and out of Indonesia. In 2003, several international guests have visited mi ni ki no, holding a workshop, a filmmaker talk, and even a filmmaking festival.

Since March 2003, mi ni ki no began to sell compilation of short films on VCD.

mi ni ki no exposes.

mi ni ki no is open to international entrants. You only have to believe in short films, as we do. You can submit your interesting, innovative, independent, unusual, unexpected, but always your best short films to us, for inclusion in our monthly as well as special programmes.
